## Policy environment

 'Building Better, Building Beautiful' Commission (Nov 2018)

Chair: Sir Roger Scruton

 To promote better design and style of homes that communities want.

- Greater community consent in new settlements.
- Make planning system work in support of better design and style.

# Policy environment

 'Building Better, Building Beautiful' Commission (Nov 2018)

### Timetable:

- Dec 2018 May 2019: gathering evidence
- July 2019: interim report
- Dec 2019: final report

Scruton has asked for examples of good rural development.

### Protecting the climate <u>and</u> addressing rural fuel poverty

### **Passivhaus**

- Carbon emissions approx 10% UK average
- Fuel bill 3 bed house £125 pa
- Highly insulated, high performance doors/ windows, minimal thermal bridging, reduced water usage
- Mechanical ventilation with heat recovery



#### Straw bale homes

- 60% reduction CO2 emissions
- Insulation 3x more than building regs
- Fire resistance 2x required





# Burnham Overy Staithe, Norfolk, church land with overage on market unit (Passivhaus)







## Co-housing

Currently growing in numbers



### Community Benefit society

- Southwold Community Hospital is an example
- 9 homes (exchanged Feb 2018)
- Community group Farm to folk café, library,
   Crèche, Starter business unit
- Getting 125 year lease



### **Almshouses**

- Housing Associations have acquired failing Almshouses
- Examples of working with existing groups to deliver a hybrid scheme
- Housing Associations are talking to major land owners to deliver joint schemes

### **CLT** schemes

- Currently on site to deliver 18
   homes in Lavenham having taken
   125 year lease.
- This is a growing sector -Cambridge



### CLT – scheme – Former Depot off Melford Road Harwood Place Lavenham



### Examples of using public sector land

- Housing Associations are working Suffolk
   County Council Examples
- Middleton Rural exception scheme plus self build – being replicated
- Barton Mills Rural exception scheme
- Stock by Nayland Almshouses
